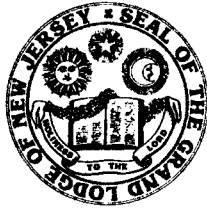

Brethren:

It is my pleasure to announce the Grand Master's Charity Fund Shoot to be held on June 21, 2008, at the Pine Belt Sportsmen's Club, 377 Stokes Road, Shamong, New Jersey.

This spectacular event features a modified sporting clays style shooting competition, and will be open to members, friends and family members. The entrant's fee of \$100.00 will cover the cost of admission, four boxes of shells, and a delicious spread of food and beverages. Children under 16 shall be admitted for the reduced fee of \$60.00. There will be prizes awarded in a number of categories.

Additionally, lodges will be permitted to sponsor teams for a fee of \$50.00. The teams may have as many participants as they wish with the three highest scores on each team will be totaled, and counted as their team score. The lodge with the highest "team score" will win the beautiful "*Grand Master's Trophy*." Lodge teams may include shooters who are not members of that lodge, but only one such score may be included in their "team score", and at least two of the scores comprising the "team score" must be those of actual members of that particular lodge.
